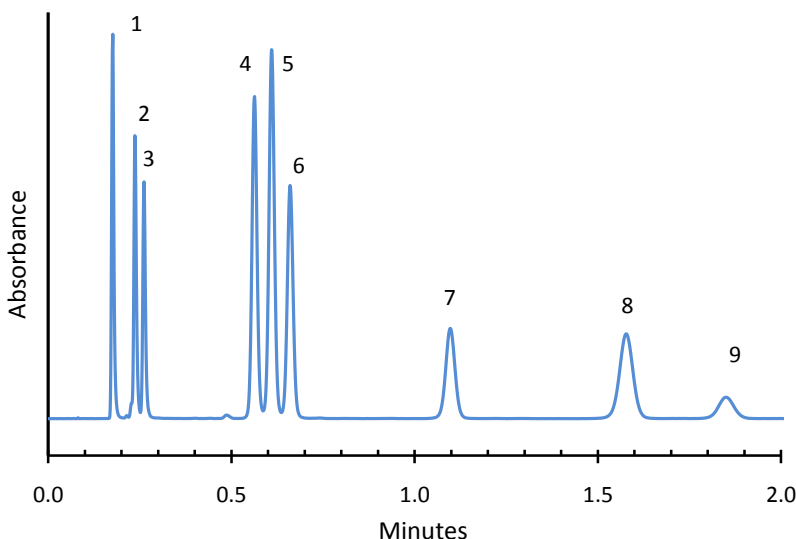

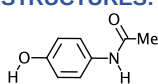

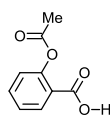

 Extra column volume: ~14 µL

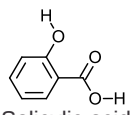
